Pop-up Blocker

For the smooth use of the Albayen system, users are advised to disable popup blockers in their respective web browsers.

Disable popup blocker in Google Chrome:

- 1. Open Google Chrome..
- 2. At the top right of Google Chrome, please press 'More', and select the 'Settings' menu.
- 3. Find the 'Privacy and Security' section, press 'Site Settings'.
- 4. Click Pop-ups and redirects.
- 5. At the top, change the setting to 'Allowed'.
- 6. Return to the Albayen School system. Press the 'Refresh' button on your web browser.

LOG IN TO THE SYSTEM

After accessing the Albayen system link, students can log in to the system. Follow the steps below for the system login process.

- Please ensure your name is registered in the system by the school administrator. If you haven't or are unsure, please contact your school administrator to register your information in the system.
- If your information has been registered by the Admin system, please enter 'student ID' in the Email and Password columns or the password set is Albayen1234. If you have changed your password, please enter your new password.
- 3. Please press the **LOG IN** button to access your account.
- If you forget your password, please click on the Forget Password section and enter the required information.




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HOME PAGE STUDENT ACCOUNT

After the login process is complete, the home page of the student account system will be displayed as in the picture on the right.

There are four (4) main menus on student accounts with different functions, namely;

- 1. Home
- 2. Subjects
- 3. Exam Results
- 4. Library



HEADER BAR

The top bar component or header bar is the most important component in the process of using the Albayen system. This component contains; starting from the left, the arrow button points to the left to hide the side menu (sidebar menu), user name, and also the student icon or avatar. Users can change the avatar icon by pressing the **Change Avatar** menu.

Users can also change their password by pressing the **Change Password** menu.

If the user wants to leave the Albayen system, the user can press the **Logout** menu.



SIDEBAR

The side menu component lists the menus and functions provided for the student account. That includes:

- 1. The Home page, displays quick links to the following main menus: Subject, School Exam and Library. Users can also access a calendar containing important school events, and a list of notifications created by class teachers or the school.
- **Subjects**, displays a list of subjects taken by students
- **Exam Results**, displays student exam result slips for each type of exam or exam that has been registered in the Albayen system.
- 4. Library, displays a collection of videos explaining 21st century learning activities, a collection of digital educational magazines, books and illustrations as additional reference material for students.


Students are advised to explore all the functions of the Albayen System that have been provided in order to increase their knowledge and skills in using the system.

HOME MENU


Apart from functioning as a quick link to access main menus such as **Subject**, **School Exam** and **Library**, the **Home** also contains the school event calendar. This calendar is maintained by school administrators to include important events throughout the year. It also contains a notification column that lists important announcements by school administrators and teachers.



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SUBJECTS MENU

This menu is provided to make it easier for students to see the list of subjects that have been registered in the Albayen system. When the user clicks on the subject name, the system will enter and display the modules, and there are also other submenus in the header, namely **Lessons**, **Materials**, **Worksheets**, and **Forums**.




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MENU SUBJECTS MENU

MULTIMEDIA STUDY AND NOTES SPACE

To access this module, press the desired subject. Each subject will display a list of subjects that students must master. After pressing the **Start Learning** button, the system will display multimedia notes in slide form, and several new menus will appear on the left side menu such as **Exercises**, **Homework**, **Quizzes** and **Test**. These menus will be explained on the next page.



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SUBJECTS MENU

EXERCISE ROOM

This column displays two categories of training; training from Albayen and training provided by subject teachers. Meanwhile, Albayen's training is divided into two types of questions; individual and group. To start answering the 'Exercise' questions, press the **Start Exercise** button.



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SUBJECTS MENU

HOMEWORK ROOM

Just like **Exercise**, the Albayen system also provides space for homework so that students can further solidify their understanding of the topics being studied. Homework aims to enable students to review lessons at home using the system. A list of homework prepared by Albayen and the teacher will be displayed once the student presses the **Homework** button. However, if students find that there is no homework display under Albayen, please inform the teacher to provide the **Homework** to the class in the teacher account for that subject.



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MENU SUBJECT MENU

QUIZZES ROOM

The **Quizzes** column displays two categories of questions; Quizzes from Albayen and Quizzes prepared by subject teachers. Albayen quizzes are divided into two types; **Quiz** and **Checkpoint Quiz**. To answer quiz questions, press the **Start Quiz** button. Students must answer quiz questions within the time period determined by the system. Once you have finished answering, press

Finish button to submit the quiz.



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SUBJECTS MENU

TEST ROOM

The Test column displays two categories of questions; Tests from Albayen and Tests are prepared by subject teachers. The Albayen test is divided into two types; **Placement Tests** and **Tests**. To answer a Test question, press button. Students must answer these two tests within the time period specified by the system.

Once you have finished answering, press putton to submit the Test.



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MENU SUBJECTS MENU

MATERIALS ROOM

The **Materials** column is a section that displays all learning and teaching materials distributed by subject teachers to students. Press button to access the materials the teacher has uploaded to the Albayen system.

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SUBJECT MENU

FORUMS ROOM

Forum space is provided by Albayen for teachers and students to interact or discuss matters related to the subject. Forums can only be created by teachers, while students can only join the forum. To join the forum, press button and the Chat section will be displayed as shown below.




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EXAM RESULT MENU

The **Exam Results** menu is provided to make it easier for students to check the test scores entered by the teacher online. In the **Exam Dashboard** column, select the desired exam year. Then, press outton to see the test results. The system will display the exam results slip as in the image below.




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LIBRARY MENU

ACCESS ADDITIONAL TEACHING RESOURCES

The **Library** menu is provided for students to access a number of additional learning materials such as digital books, digital educational magazines, illustrations and videos. This source material will be updated by Albayen from time to time. Currently, the only sources of material that students can access are the monthly edition of the digital education magazine, namely MindLoops, and videos explaining the implementation of 21st century learning activities.



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
